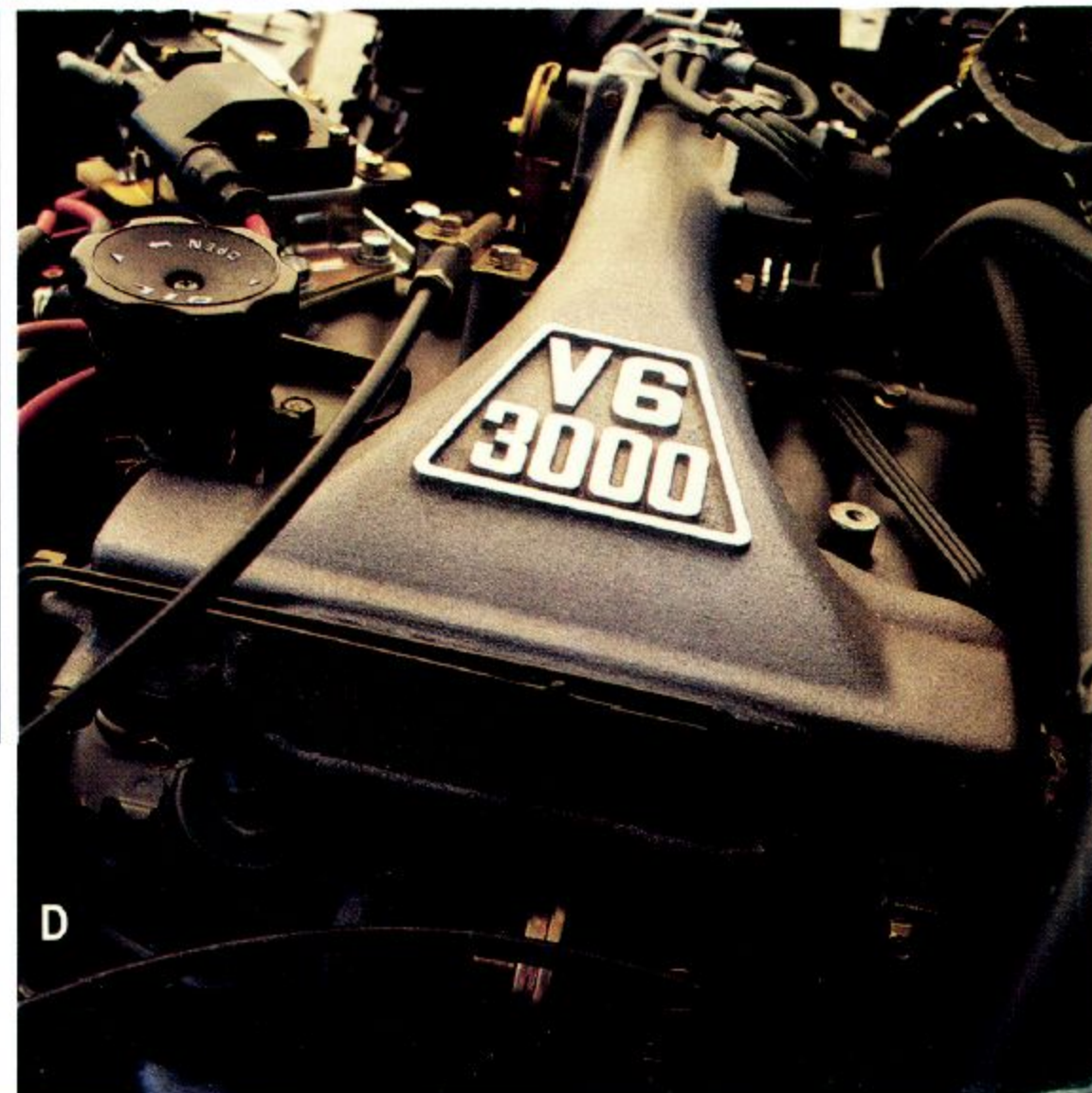
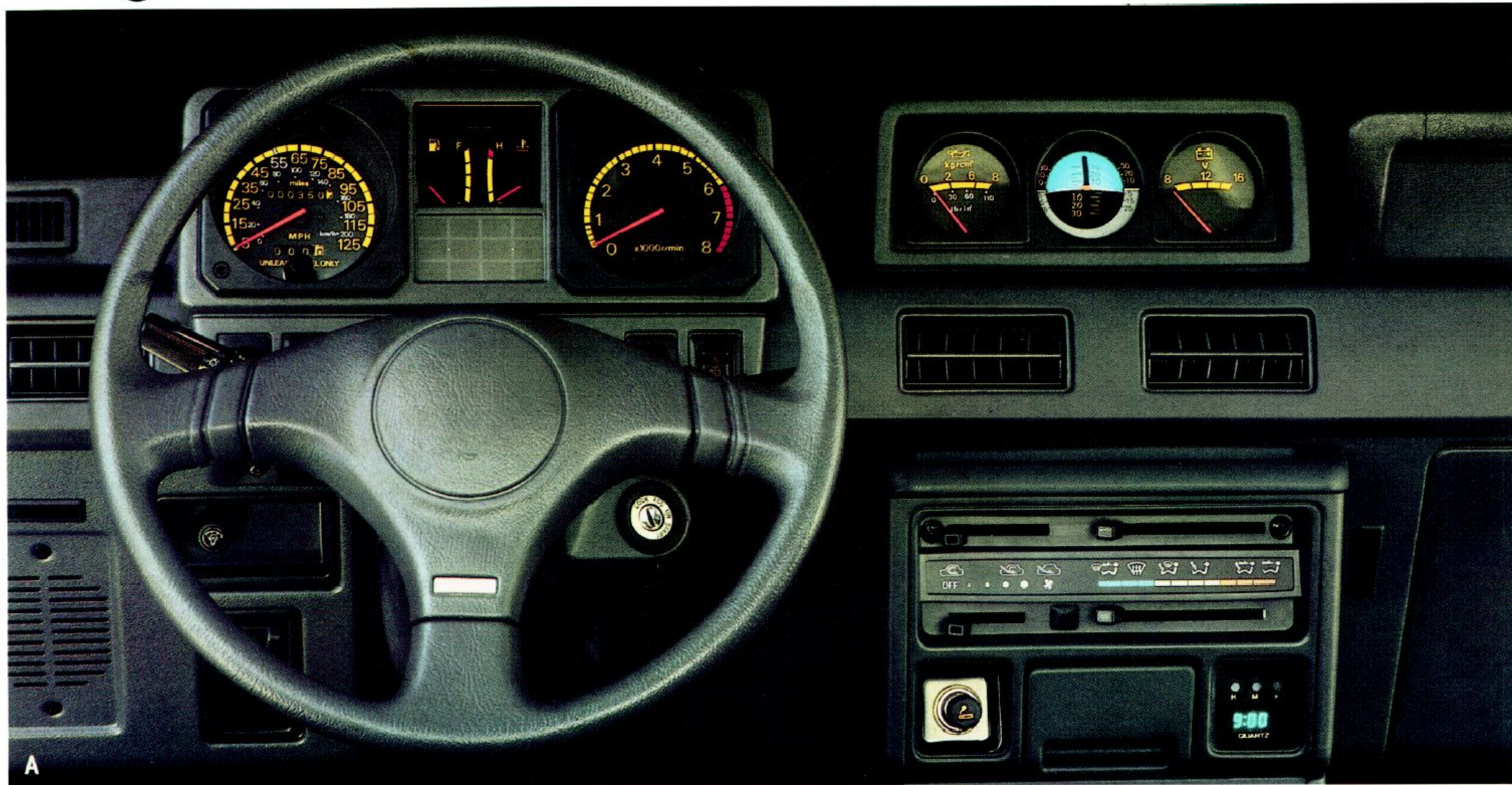


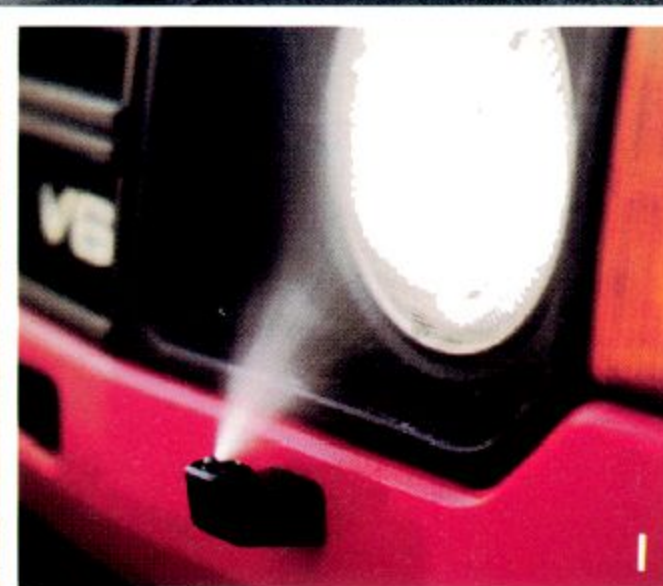
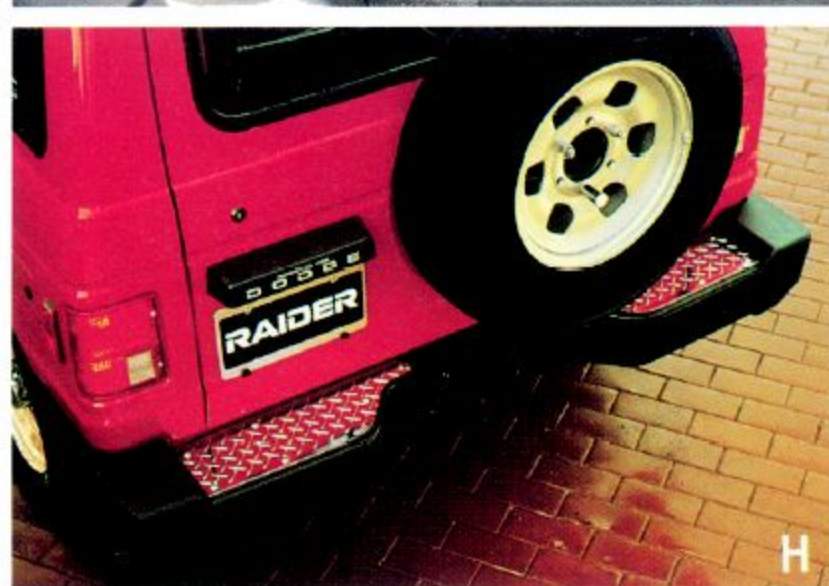
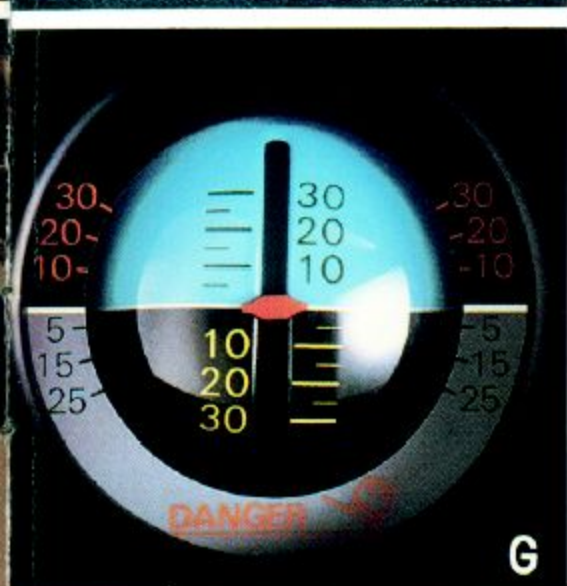
features a remote lock and release rear swing-gate with lockable spare tire carrier.

B. Raider's radio options include an AM/FM four-speaker stereo (top B); and an AM/FM four-speaker stereo with cassette tape player (bottom B).

C. Available as part of the optional Off-Road Package, a special-suspension driver's seat features added vertical cushion travel for increased comfort while driving off-road. (Also available in regular package groups.)

D. Raider's new optional 3.0-liter multi-point fuel-injected V-6 engine delivers 143 horsepower @ 5,000 rpm and 168 foot-pounds of torque @ 2,500 rpm.

E. Even with its optional rear seat in an upright position, Raider provides cargo-carrying space. Fold the rear seat down to accommodate bulky objects, or completely up and out of the way to accommodate even bigger objects.
