Ten Year SRS Inspections

Ten years after the date of vehicle manufacture, as noted on the certification plate, the SRS airbag system must be inspected by a Subaru dealer. Subaru has equipped vehicles with SRS in Legacy and SVX models since 1992.

The first systems employed only driver's side airbag protection in conjunction with the seat belts. Starting with the 1994 model year, drivers and passengers have been protected by SRS systems in Legacy, SVX and Impreza models. Loyale and Justy were not equipped with SRS and production of these models was discontinued in 1994. SRS for both driver and passenger was incorporated in the Forester model since its introduction in 1998. Front passenger side airbags were introduced for the 2000 model year in Legacy GT Limited and Outback Limited and in 2001 Forester S models with Premium Package only.

As your customers' vehicles approach their tenth anniversaries, direct them to an authorized Subaru Service Department for their SRS inspections.
