

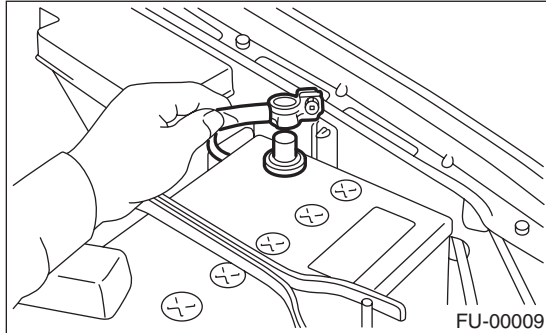

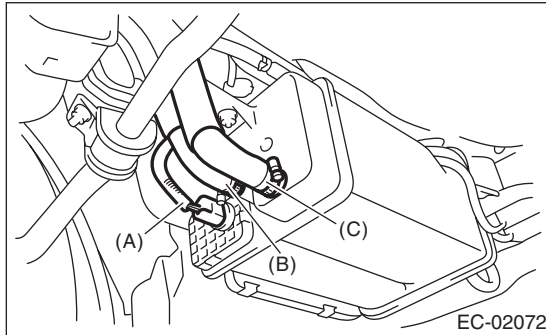
4. Canister

A: REMOVAL

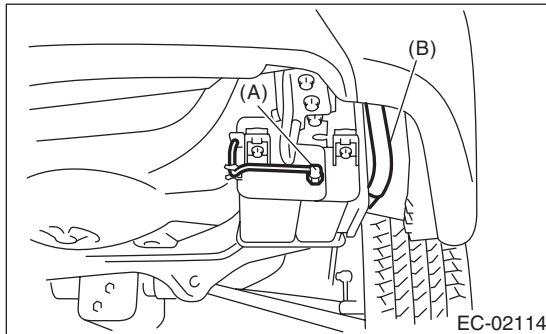
- 1) Set the vehicle on a lift.
- 2) Disconnect the ground cable from the battery.



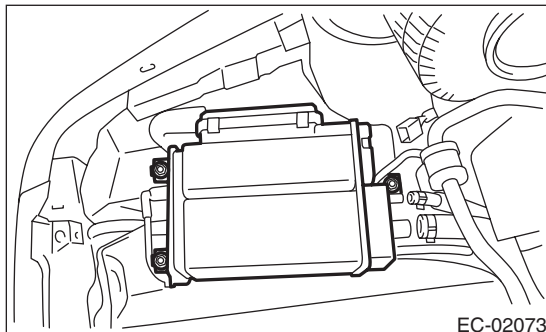
- 3) Lift up the vehicle.
- 4) Disconnect the connector (A) from drain valve.
- 5) Disconnect the evaporation hoses (B) and (C) from the canister.



- 6) Disconnect the quick connector (A) from the canister.
- 7) Disconnect the drain hose (B) from the canister.



- 8) Remove the canister from the body.



B: INSTALLATION

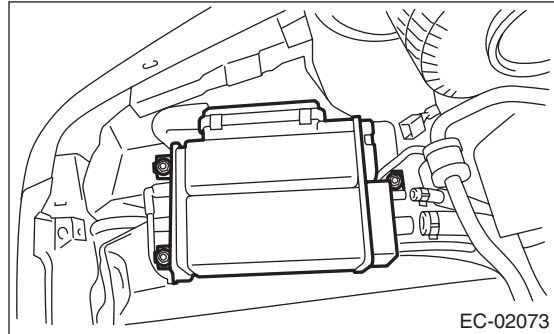
Install in the reverse order of removal.

NOTE:

Use a new retainer.

Tightening torque:

23 N·m (2.3 kgf-m, 17.0 ft-lb)



C: INSPECTION

Make sure the canister and canister hoses are not cracked or loose.
