

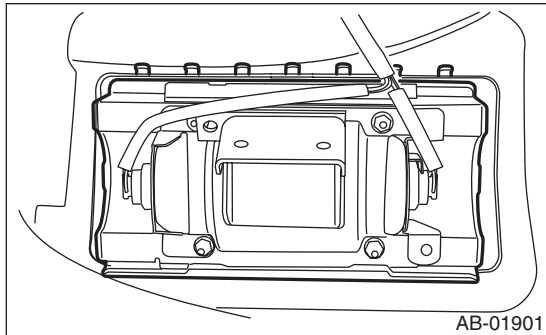
### 5. Passenger's Airbag Module

#### A: REMOVAL

##### CAUTION:

Refer to “CAUTION” of “General Description” before handling the airbag module. <Ref. to AB-5, CAUTION, General Description.>

- 1) Turn the ignition switch to OFF.
- 2) Disconnect the ground cable from battery and wait for at least 20 seconds before starting work.
- 3) Remove the instrument panel. <Ref. to EI-52, REMOVAL, Instrument Panel Assembly.>
- 4) Remove the claw, and remove the passenger's airbag module.



- 5) Refer to “CAUTION” for handling of a removed airbag module. <Ref. to AB-5, CAUTION, General Description.>

#### B: INSTALLATION

##### CAUTION:

Do not allow harness and connectors to interfere or get tangled up with other parts.

Install in the reverse order of removal.

##### *Tightening torque:*

*7.5 N·m (0.76 kgf-m, 5.5 ft-lb)*

#### C: INSPECTION

##### CAUTION:

Refer to “CAUTION” of “General Description” before handling the airbag module. <Ref. to AB-5, CAUTION, General Description.>

Check for the following, and replace the damaged parts with new parts. <Ref. to AB-13, PASSENGER'S AIRBAG MODULE, INSPECTION, Inspection Locations After a Collision.>

- Airbag module
- Harness
- Connector
- Mounting bracket
