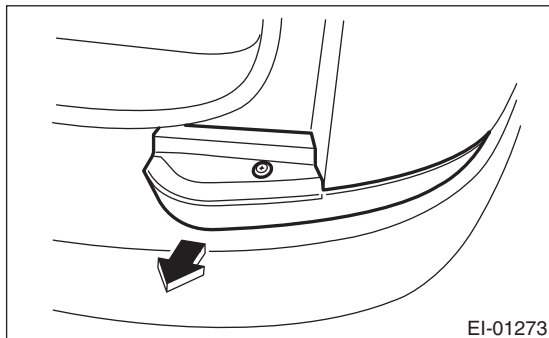


## 7. Rear Bumper

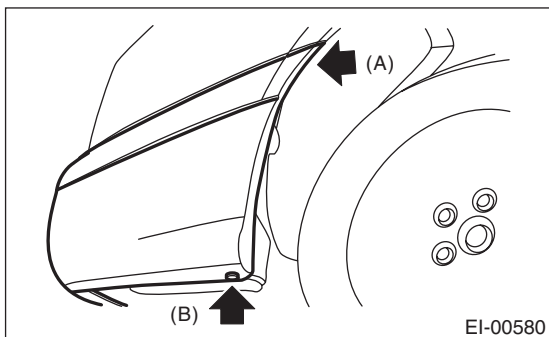
### A: REMOVAL

#### 1. REAR BUMPER FACE

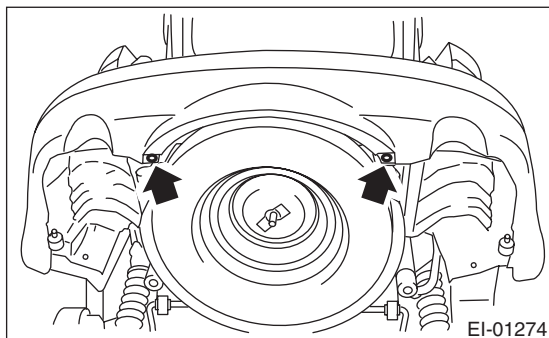
- 1) Remove the clips, and then remove the reflector.



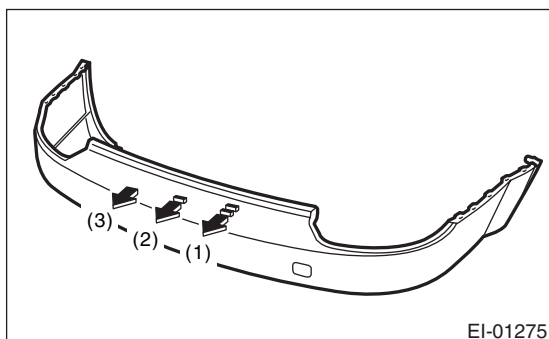
- 2) Turn over the mud guard, and remove the clip (A) and (B) inside wheel house and in the lower side of bumper.



- 3) Remove the clips on the lower side of rear bumper.



- 4) Remove the rear bumper from vehicle body.



### CAUTION:

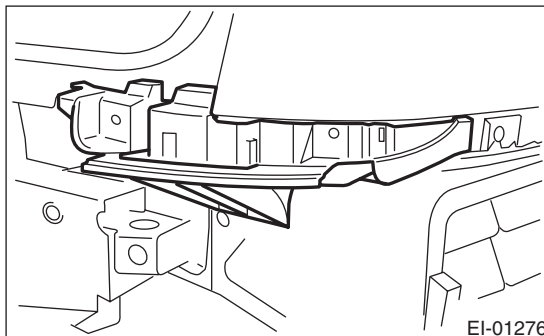
Do not pull with a excessive force. Otherwise the bracket installation area may be damaged.

### NOTE:

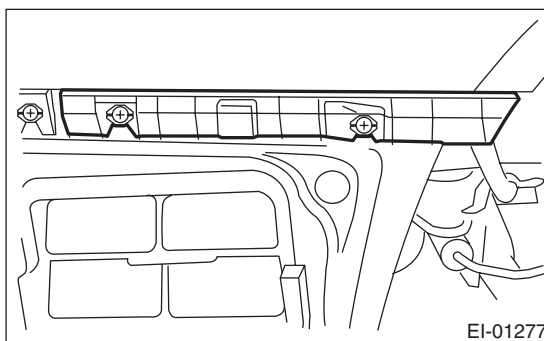
When removing the bumper face from bracket, it is easier to remove from the end in order.

#### 2. REAR BUMPER BRACKET

- 1) Remove the rear bumper face from vehicle body.
- 2) Remove the corner bracket.

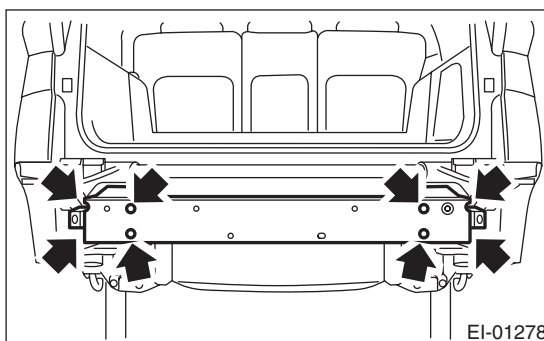


- 3) Remove the lower brackets from vehicle body.



#### 3. REAR BUMPER BEAM ASSEMBLY

- 1) Remove the rear bumper face.
- 2) Remove the energy absorber foam.
- 3) Remove the nuts, and remove the bumper beam assembly from vehicle body.



## **B: INSTALLATION**

Install in the reverse order of removal.
