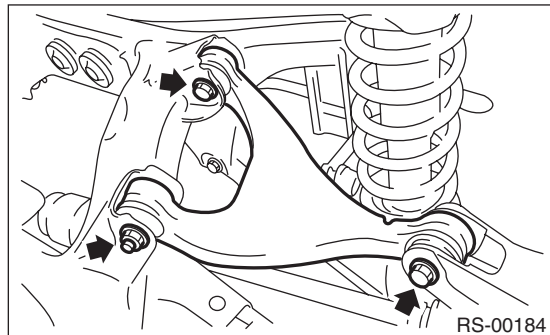


## 5. Upper Arm

### A: REMOVAL

- 1) Lift up the vehicle, and then remove the rear wheels.
- 2) Remove the bolts, and then remove the upper arm.



### B: INSTALLATION

#### CAUTION:

- Be sure to use a new self-locking nut.
- Always tighten bushings with wheels in full contact with the ground and the vehicle at curb weight.

- 1) Install in the reverse order of removal.
- 2) Inspect the wheel alignment and adjust it if necessary.

#### *Tightening torque:*

**80 N·m (8.2 kgf-m, 59 ft-lb)**

### C: INSPECTION

- 1) Visually check the upper arm for damage and deformation.
- 2) Visually check the bushing for crack, damage and fatigue.
