

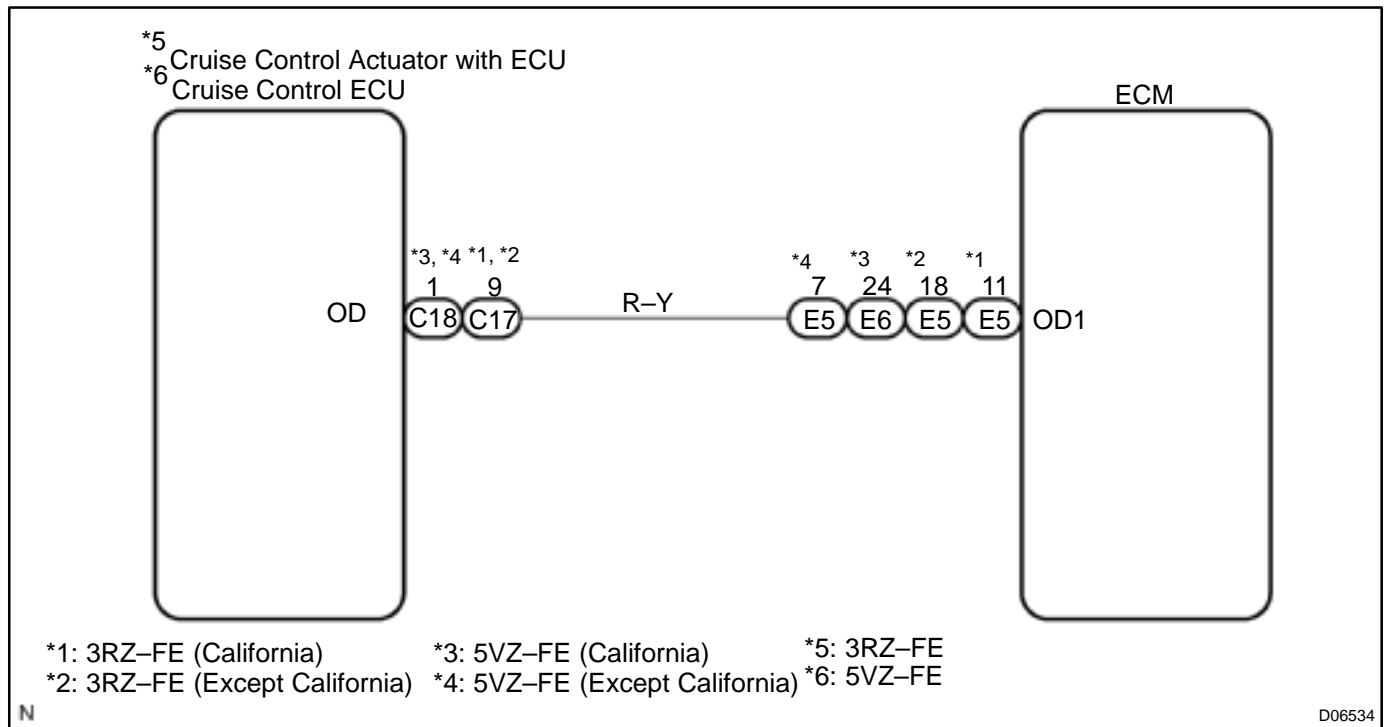
## O/D Cancel Signal Circuit

### CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

While driving uphill with cruise control activated, in order to minimize gear shifting and provide smooth cruising O/D may be prohibited temporarily under some conditions.

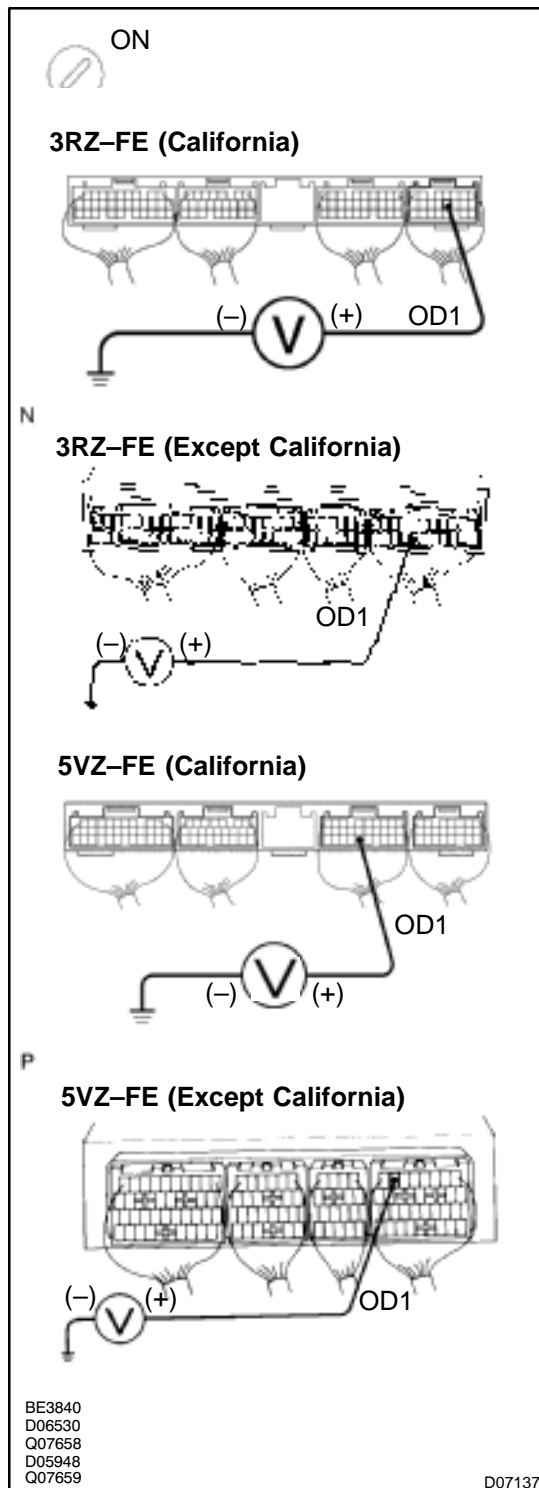
The cruise control ECU sends O/D cut signals to the ECM as necessary and the ECM cancels O/D shifting until these signals are discontinued.

## INSPECTION PROCEDURE

| 1 | Check voltage between terminal OD1 of ECM and body ground. |

**PREPARATION:**

Turn the ignition switch ON.

**CHECK:**

Measure voltage between terminal OD1 of ECM and body ground.

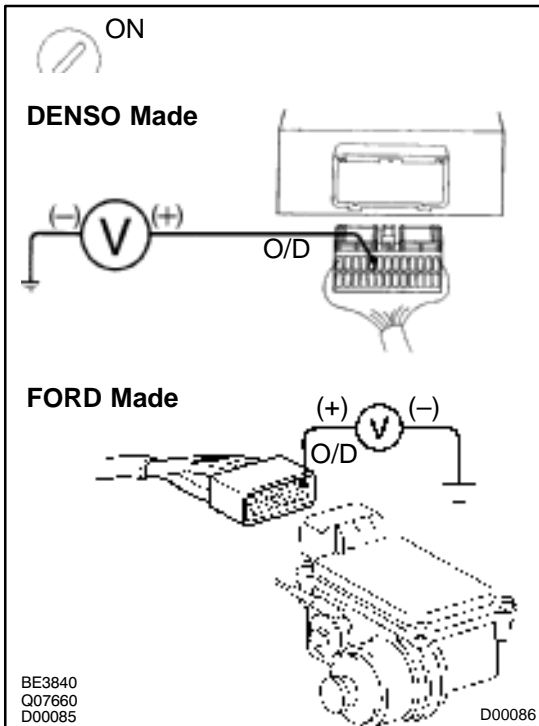
**OK:****Voltage: 4 – 6 V**

- 2 Check voltage between terminal OD of cruise control ECU harness side connector and body ground.**

**PREPARATION:**

- (a) Disconnect the cruise control ECU connector.  
(b) Turn the ignition switch ON.

**CHECK:**

Measure voltage between terminal OD of cruise control ECU harness side connector and body ground.

**OK:**

**Voltage: 4 – 6 V**

**Check and replace the cruise control ECU (See page [DI-566](#) or [DI-619](#)).**

**NG**

- 3 Check harness and connector between cruise control ECU and ECM (See page [IN-28](#)).**

**Repair or replace the harness or connector.**
